Notes on Gift Aid



Thank you for your donation to Women and Children First (UK). Your donation will contribute to saving lives and improving the wellbeing of women and children in some of the poorest countries. Please feel free to keep these notes for your records.

By using Gift Aid you make your donation worth more at no extra cost to you. Gift aid is linked to basic rate tax (currently at 20%) which means that for every pound you give us, we get an extra 25 pence from the Inland Revenue, and until 2011 the government will also add another 3p supplement—that's 28p extra per pound!

But in order to qualify for gift aid you must pay enough income or capital gains tax in the financial year to cover the amount we will claim on your gift. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please get in touch with us.

Remember you can cancel your gift aid declaration at any time by notifying Women and Children First (UK).

If your circumstances should change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return (currently 25p for each pound you give). Higher rate tax payers can claim back the difference between basic and higher rate tax.
